

# **You've successfully booked your Safari at our Kimberley or Eastern Cape locations by selecting dates and submitting your deposit. What's next?!?**

You'll need to secure airfare to Johannesburg and decide which method of transportation you would like to use to get to the designated airport based on the lodge selected for your safari. You'll also need to decide if you want to bring your own rifle or rent one from your Professional Hunter.

## **Rifle:**

It costs approx. \$175 to get the permit done in advance to bring your own rifle(s) over to South Africa. You can bring a couple of rifles on this permit, but they must be single shot or bolt action and cannot be the same caliber as any other rifle on your permit. You're allowed 11lbs of ammo in total.

Most clients prefer to rent a rifle from their PH for \$50/day plus any ammo they use on their hunt. This alleviates the need for the permit and can speed up your time going through customs.

## **Transportation to Kimberley or E. Cape:**

Lastly you'll need to decide on what you want to happen upon arriving into Johannesburg. Unless designated, we collect our clients at the closest airport to the selected lodge to begin their safari. We have two options for you to consider:

### **Option 1 – Africa Sky Lodge and a “Domestic” Flight**

This option is a very popular option. Upon arrival into Johannesburg, you will be met at the airport and shuttled to the Africa Sky Lodge for the night. This includes a shuttle back to the airport the next morning for your flight in-country. You will be picked up at that airport by a member of our staff and driven to the hunting lodge. Most cases, your hunt begins shortly after lunch. **Approximated Costs associated with this option are as follows:**

\$175/person/night for the lodging  
\$185/person round trip for the in-country flight  
\$40/rifle security fee each way at the designated airport

**\*Note – Transporting ammunition on this flight requires any and all ammo be in a separate, locked piece of luggage designated solely for ammunition. Nothing else can ride in the suitcase with the ammo on the domestic flight so plan accordingly for this if you're bringing your own firearm.**

### **Option 2 – Ground Transportation to Kimberley or Eastern Cape**

Many clients opt to have us hire road transportation for them. The distance from the airport to Kimberley is approximately 320 miles and about 650 miles to the Eastern Cape which will take about five to six hours to Kimberley or 11-12 hours to the East Cape. The cost for this method of transportation is between \$450-\$900 each way split between all White Lion clients in the vehicle. There are instances where this can be a more cost-effective method of reaching the lodge after your long travel day, but it significantly extends the travel day itself.
